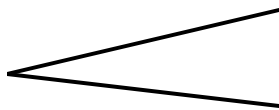

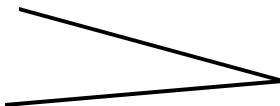

| tempo     | smooth notes                          |
| presto    | plucking the string                   |
