

REMEMBER: *Music was used for many different things in the Middle Ages, including dancing, jousting, and spreading news.*



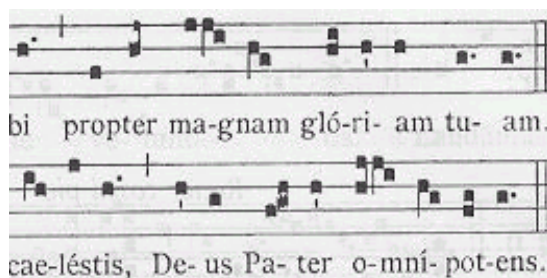
These instruments that look like “umbrella handles,” are called crumhorns. The bigger ones have a lower sound, while the smaller ones have a higher sound.

Do you think you would like living during the Middle Ages?

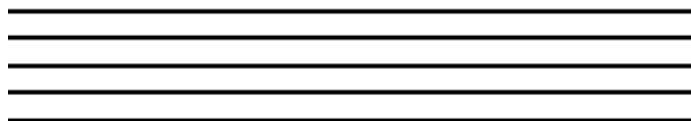
