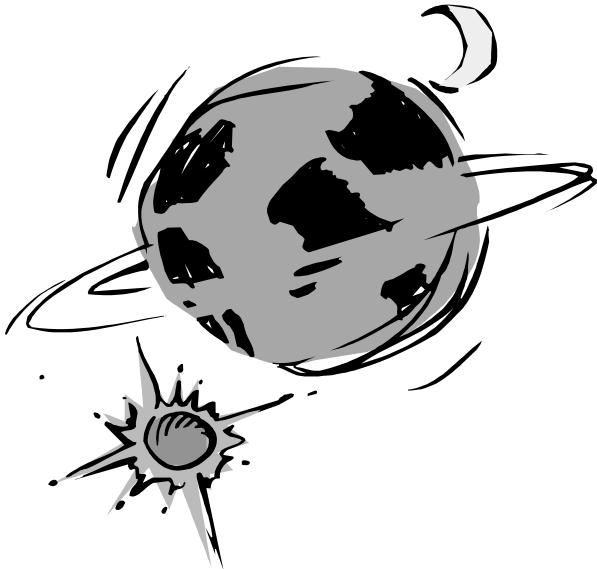


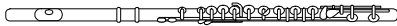
# SPACE MUSIC II

- Venus         like our moon with craters, has an atmosphere
- Pluto          has rings of rock and ice

Write the name underneath the instrument you would hear in a marching band (if it played on earth):



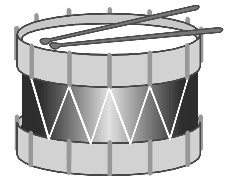
