

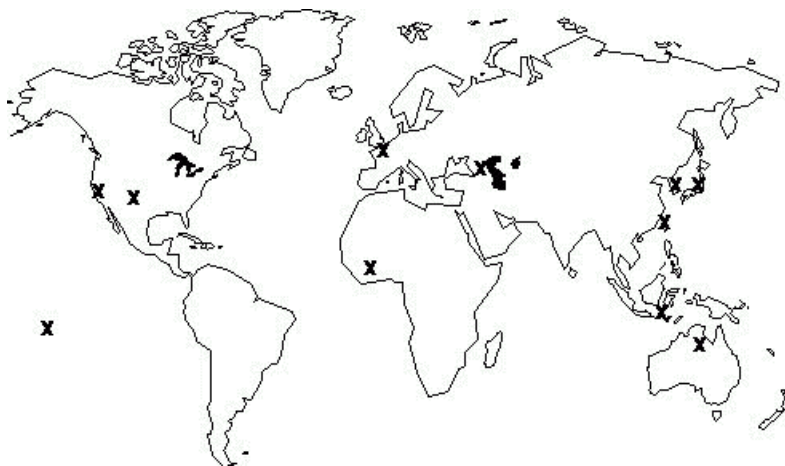
**REMEMBER:** Choral music means lots of people singing together. The Santa Fe Desert Chorale has four voice parts: soprano, alto, tenor and bass.
