The American West is made up of 22 states: from Louisiana north to Wisconsin, and from Missouri east to California. Color the "American West" on the U.S. map.

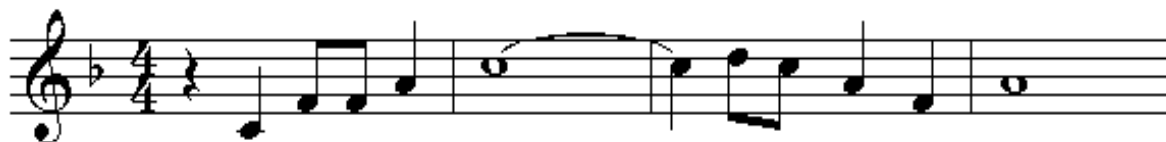
While they were working cowboys carried small instruments like harmonicas or jaw harps. Back at the ranch they had lots more to choose from.
