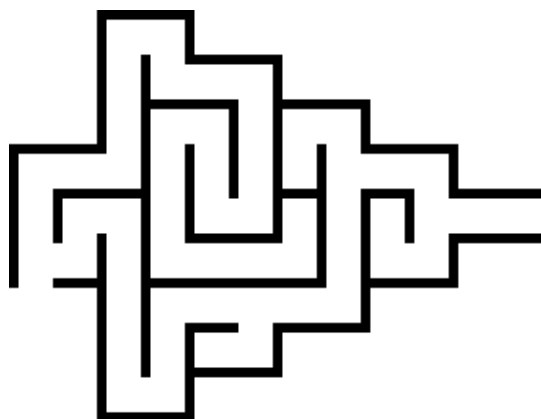


WORLD HARPS

The word **harpa**, or **harp**, comes from ancient words which mean **to pluck**. A rock painting of a harp-like instrument was discovered in France, which is about 17,000 years old. There are many different types of harps: big harps, little harps, folk harps, concert harps, lap harps, even Jollip harps!
