## What is rhythm?

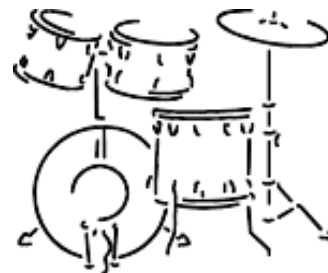
